MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Members,

On behalf of the Committee, I would like to welcome everyone back to the Slovenian Summer Camp for the 2007 season. At our AGM in February, we reviewed the 2006 season, as well as set some goals for 2007. These goals include the completion of work around the hall and playground now that all of the Town, Region and Provincial reviews are over, the installation of a new kitchen exhaust hood in the hall to comply with fire code requirements and the installation of a fence along the new northern boundary to name a few. A copy of the minutes from the AGM is included with this newsletter. I invite all of the members to read it.

With the addition of the buffer zone (lands to the north), I invite the members to explore, bike, hike and enjoy this new area free from cottages. At the end of last year a number of paths were cut through the brush which we will be maintaining this year. These will become future walking or biking trails. We have also placed markers along the future fence line and we would like to remind all of the members to remain to the south of these.

Last season we had to acknowledge that the days of "large" camp fires are over so this is just a reminder to all of the members that small camp fires used for "cooking purposes" are still allowed as long as they are controlled, manned and maintained. Remember to put out the fire when you go to bed. Wood for these fires is available by the sand pit area for any member looking for wood to burn at the Camp by their cottage.

Similar to last year, garbage that is collected in the bin can not contain recyclables. Handling the recyclables generated by the Hall and the Sports Deck is already a difficult task, thus we ask all of the members to take all recyclables home to put out with their garbage. We did look at getting recycling pickup as well, however it is not offered by private garbage companies in our area as of yet.

But it will not be just all work, in July we all look forward to Slovenski Dan, Poletni Večer as well as all of the other sports events that are planned this year.

I hope that everyone will participate and help whenever possible and that you will have an enjoyable season once the gates will be officially open on Mother's Day for the Camps' 49th season.

Smoke Alarms & Electrical Systems

As you are opening the cottage and getting it ready for the summer season ahead, take a little extra time to ensure that the your smoke detector is still operational and replace the battery. During the winter while walking through the Camp one could hear a lot of smoke detectors beeping, indicating low battery conditions. As cold weather is hard on batteries we suggest putting in a fresh pair and testing your detectors to ensure that they are operational.

For those cottages that have fuses rather than breakers, please ensure that the correct fuse size is installed and that the fuses have not been shorted out with "pennies" or other such devices. These are a safety item that protect everyone.

As mentioned at the AGM, our initial review of the electrical systems throughout the Camp yielded some surprises. As a first step the Committee will be requiring any member doing work on their cottage to ensure that they have;

- Proper underground wiring in place between the power supply and their cottage/trailer,
- Both a disconnect as well as a breaker/fuse panel in their cottage,
- That the panel/disconnect is located 1.5 m above the floor.
- That the breaker/fuse sizes match the wire size being used.

Over the coming year(s) we will also be requiring any cottages that do not have all of the above in-place to upgrade their systems. This upgrade to the electrical connections will be much like to upgrades and repairs that we did to the water system so many years ago.

WATER

With new rules coming into effect in 2007, that require the Camp to keep daily logs of the water system use and chlorine levels, the Camp undertaking an upgrade to the system. This will involve installing a new chlorine pump and control panel that will let the Camp monitor the chlorine levels and record them on a daily level to a memory stick. This is similar to the way a digital camera saves pictures. We do not anticipate any problems with the installation of the system however there may be some time that is required to fine tune the system. This may mean that for a short period of time members can expect changes to the chlorine levels in the lines.

Non-Member Access

The solution to non-member access is that **all members have to police this**. If you see someone that does not belong, (non-Slovenian)...go up and question them, ask them which member they are a guest of and where that member is. If they are not a guest, let them know this is a private park and they must be sponsored by a member. Having everyone police this will discourage people that have no links to the Slovenian Community from using the Camp's facilities, unless they are direct guests of a member. If they are the following rules apply:

Guest Rules:

- Guests to SSC that have been invited up to the sponsoring member's cottage must be accompanied by the member.
- Guests are not permitted to stay at the camp without the sponsoring member.
- The number of guests should be limited. (to the discretion of the Committee)
- No large groups are permitted unless authorized by the SSC Committee.
- Payment for daily admission must be made.
- The sponsoring member is fully responsible for the behaviour of their guests, remember that we are a family friendly summer camp.

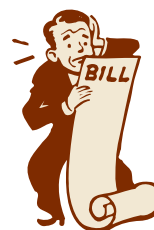

Garbage Garbage Garbage

As mentioned at the AGM, over the last year we have seen an increase in the amount of garbage that the Camp has had to dispose of as well as additional work placed on the grounds keeper. In order to keep the grounds looking clean we ask that all the members;

- Only use the garbage containers around the grounds when necessary.
- If you are on your way out from the grounds drop your garbage off on the way out rather than leaving it in garbage pails. This keeps the area cleaner, the smells down and frees the groundskeeper up for other duties.
- The garbage bin is for household (food) waste only. Items such as propane cylinders, BBQ's, refrigerators, chairs, sofas, doors, windows, construction waste and other items that we find by the bin that are not appropriate, will be returned to their owners.
- Please do not throw your garbage over the fences onto neighbouring properties, so there will not be any complaints against us.
- All recyclable materials must be taken to your home and not disposed of at the Camp.

Every year the camp has to pay extra to dispose of these items, as mentioned at the AGM we are not a garbage service. If you have items to dispose of take them to your local municipal waste site. We can only cut down on this inappropriate disposal of items with your help.

Recycling

Bolton Community Recycling Center is located on 109 Industrial Road off Regional road #50 or Nunnville Rd. going South, 2nd street past the tracks. Hours are 8.30 am - 4.30 pm, Tuesday to Saturday. They accept many materials. For more information call 905-584-2216. Taking materials to this center will minimize SSC waste removal costs and will keep our camp clean.
