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Water System

As discussed at the AGM, the major improvements the camp will be undertaking this year are the modifications to the water system. Since these modifications are extensive they will be phased in over the next few months.

The first phase will be the completion of the new water lines that we started in the fall. For those of you that have not connected to the new system please do so as soon as possible since the old system will not be re-activated this year. For those of you that have not connected to the system as of yet, please co-ordinate with the maintenance co-coordinator for the valve box you are to connect to.

The 2nd phase entails performing tests on the well water and selecting filters based on the results of these tests. We hope to have the filters in place before the end of May as well as the new interconnects between the pump houses. As a result, those members that are currently served by the south system will have their water on a **few weeks later** than the traditional Mother's Day start.

The 3rd phase which will be initiated after Procesija will involve installing an underground storage tank for the clean treated water and re-piping the systems so that once complete the entire camp will be receiving treated water from the underground tank.

Since we are not only installing a new system to supply water to the camp but also interconnecting it with the existing system, there will be periods of time throughout the whole year that water will not be available. These periods may be as short as a few hours, to as long as a week or more, obviously we will attempt to make these outages as short as possible and we will try to inform the members in advance of any prolonged outages.

Valves

On the right are tables showing the valve box numbers and the cottages that are connected to them. These will be posted in the hall and held by the maintenance crew. Be familiar with the location of the valves in case there is a leak at any of the cottages.

As mentioned at the AGM, over the last year we have seen an increase in the amount of garbage that the Camp has had to dispose of as well as additional work placed on the grounds keeper. In order to keep the grounds looking clean we ask that all the members;

- Only use the garbage containers around the grounds when necessary.
- If you are on your way out from the grounds drop your garbage off on the way out rather than leave it in garbage pails. This keeps the area cleaner, the smells down and frees the groundskeeper up for other duties.
- The garbage bin is for household (food) waste only, items such as propane cylinders, BBQ's, refrigerators, chairs, sofas, doors, windows, construction waste and other items that we find by the bin are not appropriate and if left by the bin will be returned to their owners.

Every year the camp has to pay extra to dispose of these items, as mentioned at the AGM we are not a garbage service. If you have items to dispose of take them to your local municipal waste site. We can only cut down on this inappropriate disposal of items with your help.

Recycling

Bolton Community Recycling Center is located on 109 Industrial road off Regional road #50 or Nunnville Rd. going South, 2nd street past the tracks. Hours are 8.30 am - 4.30 pm, Tuesday to Saturday. They accept many materials.

For more information call 905-584-2216. Taking materials to this center will minimize SSC waste removal costs and will keep our camp clean.

Spring is here and so are new taxes. On April 22, and after months of discussions and arguments Caledon Council increased the property taxes by 4.00%. At first Councilors approved 3.2%, later a vote was taken to raise taxes by another 0.8% to hire more people. The average inflation rate over the past 10 years was 3% and as per councillor's comments this is a first tax increase in Caledon during the last 10 years. Enclosed with this newsletter is the 2002 maintenance and tax invoices. The mill rate as calculated is shown with your assessed value.
